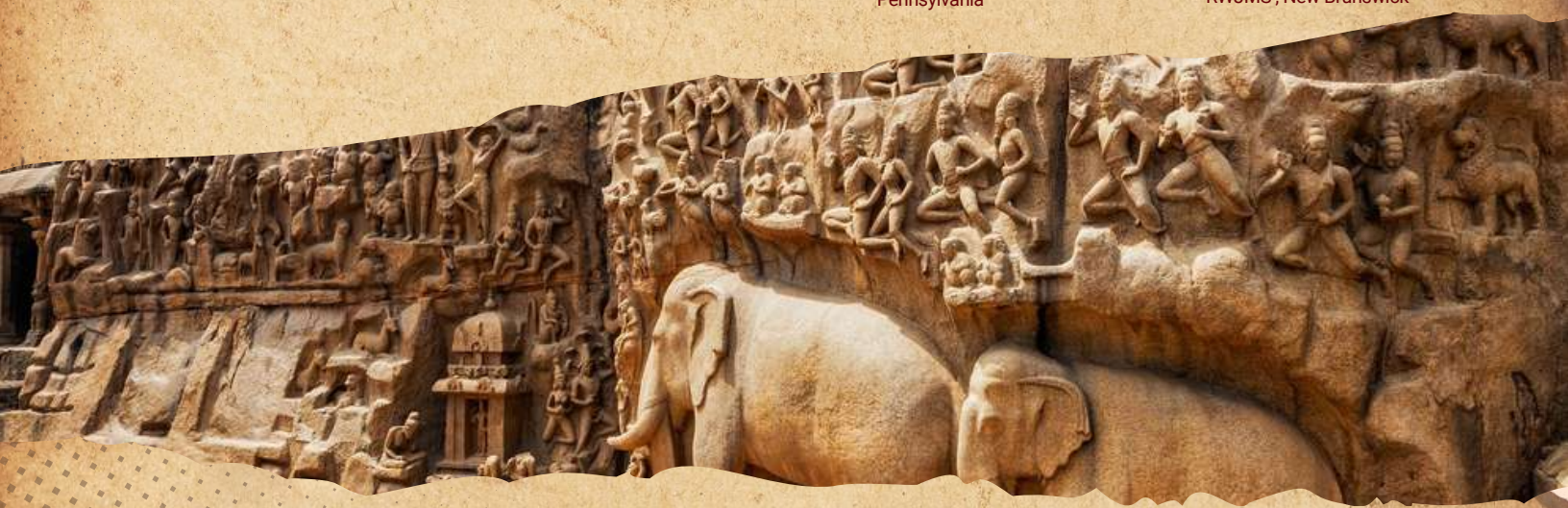

Inbound & Outbound Travel Options

Option 1: Via Chennai (Recommended for international connections)

Chennai ↔ Puducherry: Fly into Chennai International Airport (MAA). Frequent road transfers are available between Chennai and Puducherry. The organising team can be contacted to facilitate if needed.

Option 2: Direct Flights to/from Puducherry (PNY)

You can fly directly into Puducherry via IndiGo connecting flights through regional hubs. Note: These are small 72-seat ATR flights. Standard check-in weight limits apply, but overhead cabin baggage space is significantly smaller than usual.

To Puducherry (Inbound):

From Hyderabad (HYD): Departs at 11:45 AM, arrives at 1:40 PM.

From Bangalore (BLR): Departs at 4:00 PM, arrives at 5:10 PM.

From Puducherry (Outbound):

To Hyderabad (HYD): Departs at 5:30 PM, arrives at 7:20 PM.

To Bangalore (BLR): Departs at 2:00 PM, arrives at 3:15 PM.

Puducherry and the surrounding coastal region offer a beautiful blend of French colonial heritage, South Indian culture, and nature:

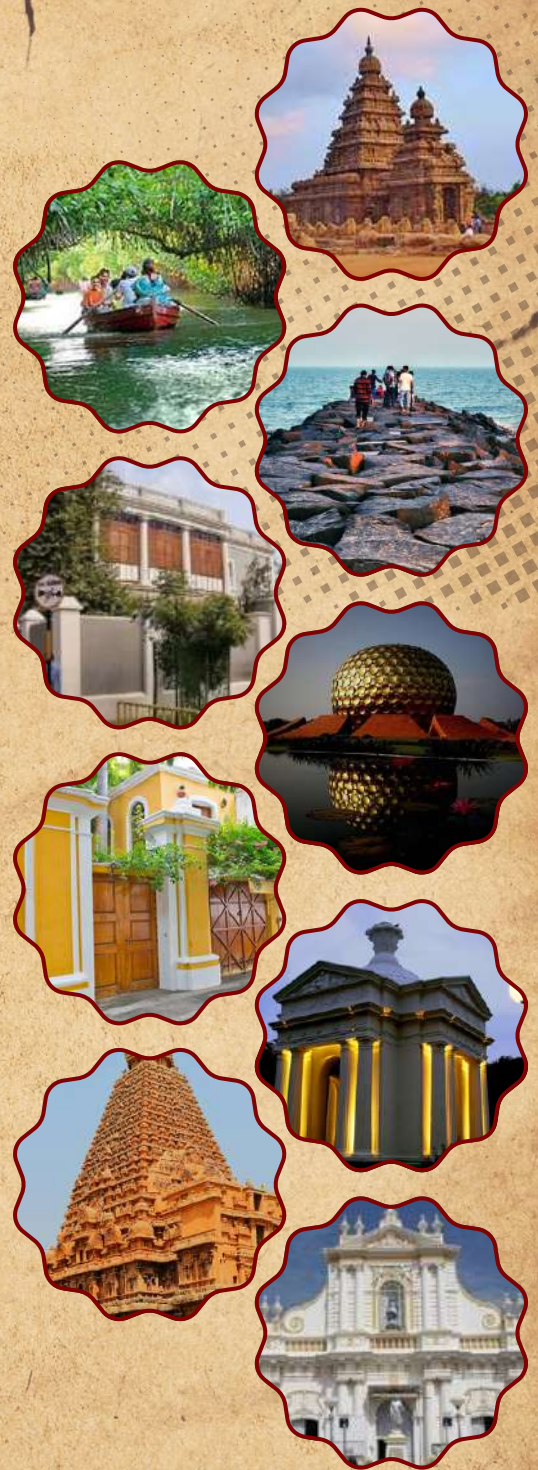
